Historic Day in Columbus, Ohio

On May 1, 2014, the co-founders of Mattie Miracle were invited to Columbus, Ohio to deliver a keynote address at the Association of Pediatric Hematology Oncology Educational Specialists (**[APHOES](#)**) and Association for the Education of Children with Medical Needs (**[AECMN](#)**) joint conference. While at that conference the co-founders were introduced to a key representative from the Ohio Department of Health who was interested in Mattie Miracle's message and vision for the development of a National Childhood Cancer Psychosocial Standard of Care.

Mattie Miracle was invited back to Columbus, Ohio on June 20, 2014, to deliver a **keynote address at the Ohio Department of Health Conference**. Ohio is re-examining its State cancer plan and developing a comprehensive pediatric psychosocial cancer care plan in 2015, the first of its kind in the United States. Making this conference a historical event! The purpose of a State plan is to provide an organized approach to cancer prevention and control efforts for an entire State. A plan is intended for use by individuals and organizations, in all areas of cancer prevention and control, statewide.

Mattie Miracle was invited to the conference to deliver a keynote address entitled, "**The Journey Toward a National Psychosocial Standard of Care for Childhood Cancer**." The co-founders were graciously introduced by Dr. Kathryn Kirkpatrick the Vice Chairperson of APHOES (an organization Mattie Miracle has recently become professionally connected

Educating Trauma Counselors

On June 21, 2014, Mattie Miracle was invited to the George Washington University to deliver a two hour lecture on "**Childhood Cancer and Its Effects.**" The audience was comprised of master's and doctoral level students training to become trauma counselors.

The Foundation presented an overview of childhood cancer facts, information about Mattie Miracle's mission and activities, and then highlighted the research literature on trauma and childhood cancer. The story of Mattie Brown was integrated throughout the presentation, which not only enabled the students to learn about a heroic seven year old boy, but through these stories and hearing reflections and insights from Mattie's battle with cancer, the clinical significance of the research literature came alive.

Students were also introduced to a model which mental health professionals frequently use to help them understand the nature, symptomatology, and interventions for medical traumatic stress. In addition to the didactic presentation, students were given time to work on a case study in small groups in order to apply the intervention model they learned to a patient case.

The President of Mattie Miracle captured the above photo of this dynamic class along with one of her counseling mentors, Dr. Sylvia Marotta (front row, left), the class' instructor. Mattie Miracle believes in educating the next generation about the psychosocial impact of childhood cancer and welcomes the opportunity to be able to do this within an academic setting in order to prepare clinicians for the issues they will inevitably face within the community.
